### Description:

YNCC will host an 8-week pilot SAT workshop, offering free SAT classes utilizing materials and training from a private SAT tutoring company – Elite Educational. We will recruit 11<sup>th</sup> grade students from Lincoln High School who have an interest in attending a 4-year university to attend the workshop. The course curriculum will offer a diagnostic test, tutorials on Math, Verbal, and Writing to improve their SAT scores, and a college workshop or tour to guide students on applying to a university. We are looking for volunteers who have an interest in teaching SAT for inner-city youth in either subjects of Math, Verbal, or Writing and are available Saturday mornings. Volunteers will attend a one-day training hosted by Elite to learn the materials and techniques to teach their subject matter. No recent SAT test familiarization is necessary. When signing up, please list the subject area you are interested to teach (if you are able to teach in more than one area – please indicate this as we may fall short in another subject matter). Imagine the hope & future this might provide for the inner-city youth, as you sacrifice one hour each for 9 Saturdays!!

### Tentative Schedule:

- 2/14: SAT Training for Volunteers
- 2/21: 1<sup>st</sup> day of SAT class. Diagnostic test administered.
- 2/28 – 4/4: SAT workshop
- 4/11: Exit test administered
- 4/18: Review exam, college workshop/tour
- 5/2: Students take SAT administered by the College Board.

Expected Time Commitment on the Day of Service: 1.5 ~ 2 hours  
(teachers will be scheduled anywhere from 8:30 am – 12.30 pm.)
