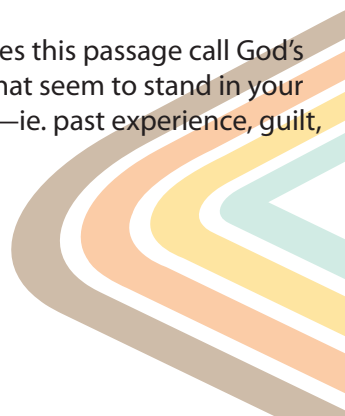

2. Read Hebrews 10:22 and 4:16. What does this passage call God’s children to do? What are some things that seem to stand in your way of doing what you are called to do—ie. past experience, guilt, hurt, and etc?



3. In Hebrews 10:23, God calls us to “hold fast unwaveringly to the hope we profess.” What is this hope referring to and what is the source of that hope?

4. Read Hebrews 10:24-25. In it, God’s word calls for two specific actions. What are they?
